## What you'll need


- Fabrics are from 'Sock Monkey' range
- 60cm Sock Monkey Patch – royal (a)
- 20cm Sock Monkey Allover – royal (b)
- 20cm Sock Monkey Stripe – royal (c)
- 20cm Sock Monkey Buttons – yellow (d)
- 20cm Sock Monkey Argyle – orange (e)
- 50cm Sock Monkey Buttons – red (border) (f)
- 30cm Sock Monkey Argyle – red (binding) (g)
- 1.2m Sock Monkey Knit – royal (backing) (h)
- 20cm Textures blender – orange
- 20cm Textures blender – aqua
- 1.2m Sew Easy cotton/bamboo batting
- Matching Gutermann 100% cotton thread
- Rotary cutter, mat & quilters rulers
- Quilting pins, tape measure
- Scissors, seam ripper
- Hand needle
- Sewing machine with ¼" foot and walking foot

All fabrics should be 100% cotton, washed & pressed.  
¼" seam allowance used throughout unless otherwise indicated.  
Read all instructions carefully before commencing.



## CUTTING

- From Sock Monkey Patch fabric cut a panel 4 patches x 4 patches allowing a ¼" seam allowance around all sides. It will be a rectangle not a square.
- From both Sock Monkey Allover and Stripe fabrics cut 1 x 6" strip then crosscut each into 3 x 6" squares (6 squares in total).
- From both Sock Monkey yellow Buttons and orange Argyle fabrics cut 1 x 6" strip then crosscut each into 4 x 6" squares (8 squares in total).
- From aqua Textures blender cut 1 x 6" strip then crosscut into 4 x 6" squares.
- From orange Textures blender cut – 1 x 2¾" strip, crosscut into 2 x 17" strips; 1 x ¾" strip, crosscut into 2 x 17" strips for inner border.
- From Sock Monkey red Buttons fabric cut 4 x 4½" strips for outer borders.
- From Sock Monkey red Argyle fabric cut 4 x 2½" strips for binding.

## QUILT TOP

1. Sew one 2¾" x 17" inner border strip to each side of the Patch fabric panel. Press seams towards border and trim if necessary. Sew one ¾" x 17" inner border strip to the top and bottom edges of the panel and press.
2. Refer to image to lay out the 6" squares around the bordered panel.
3. Sew together the four squares on the left side then sew to the left side of the panel. Repeat using the four squares on the right-hand side.
4. Sew together the five squares across the top then sew to the top of the panel. Repeat using the five squares along the bottom.
5. For the outer border sew one 4½" red Buttons fabric border strip to each side of the quilt. Press seams towards border and trim off any excess fabric. Sew remaining strips to the top and bottom of the quilt, press and trim off any excess fabric.
6. Layer backing, batting and quilt top, baste together. Quilt as desired. Join the 4 x 2½" binding strips to make one long strip. Press in half lengthwise and bind mitering corners. Attach a label or sign and date your quilt.
