

LIDCOMBE POWER CENTRE CHRISTMAS HAMPER GIVEAWAY

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The competition is open to all current Australian residents who show proof of purchase a product in Lidcombe Power Centre throughout the duration of the competition. Then complete a guessing competition entry form and attach a copy of their receipt from purchases during the period 9am 1st Dec 2011 until 4pm on 20th Dec 2011.
2. The competition commences at 9.00am AEST on **Thursday 1st December 2011** and closes at 4.00pm AEST on Tuesday 20th December 2011 (the "**Promotion Period**").
3. During the Promotion Period, upon a purchase in any store located in Lidcombe Power Centre each customer during the Promotion Period will receive one entry into the competition for every product purchased once per day only.
